

ANNOUNCEMENT:

Scholarship for Doctoral Degree in Business Administration IAE Business School Argentina: *Dept of Integral Sustainable Development.*

The Department of Integral Sustainable Development of IAE Business School Argentina, in partnership with B Academy, is inviting Latin American professionals willing to deepen their studies in Business Administration to apply for a PhD Scholarship focused on the research of new economic actors who work under parameters of cooperation and co-construction and towards a regenerative and inclusive economy such as System B and B Corporations. Applicants will be advised by Professor Hector Rocha (*Ph.D London Business School*) (www.iae.edu.ar/hrocha).



Objective

The Doctorate in **Business Administration** aims at forming the future scholars of the region with a focus on research in emerging economies in general and Latin America in particular. Doctorate students will be exposed to high-level research methodologies and will enjoy an intensive adviser-student relationship.

In this particular announcement, our aim is to be able to finance the studies of a doctorate student and his or her research, focusing on general administration and in inter-organizational collaboration of companies committed to generate a positive impact in society and in nature.

Applicants are requested to submit a research proposal that aggregates relevant knowledge to both the field of study and the actors involved and which will also turn into articles to be published in the most renowned journals specialized in management.

- The scholarship includes the cost of the program (US\$ 30,000) and a monthly expense allowance of US\$ 900.
- Granting of the scholarship implies full-time dedication to the doctorate for 2 years and the commitment by the student to teach at Universidad Austral during this period.



Financing

The scholarship will cover the cost of enrollment for the doctorate, corresponding to US\$ 30,000, and a monthly expense allowance of \$ US\$ 900 for the three years of the program.



Program

The Doctorate in Business Administration requires three years of full-time study. The first year includes the courses and readings necessary to prepare the doctoral thesis, a task that students will carry out in the subsequent years.

During the first year, students take courses in those disciplines in which they want to acquire fundamentals, methodological guidance and techniques for the drawing up of their doctoral thesis. They also take specialization courses according to the theme of their thesis.

During the second and third years, students develop their thesis proposal, end it and defend it. They also rely on specialization courses.

This Doctorate in Business Administration was accredited by CONEAU – Proyecto N° 10.704/10; Sesión n° 336/11.

Requirements

To request entry, applicants must:

- Have a Master's degree in Business Administration or related disciplines;
- Demonstrate a high potential for research; Demonstrate a genuine interest in contributing with their studies to the construction of an inclusive and regenerative economy.

To apply for the PhD scholarship, students must present:

- The application form duly completed;
- A photocopy of their identity document (DNI for Argentines, passport for foreigners);
- Three 4x4 colored photographs;
- Argentine degree: a photocopy of the front and back (on the same sheet of paper) of the original diploma previously authenticated by the Ministry of Education. If the degree is in process, a declaration that attests it should be presented;
- Foreign degree: a photocopy of the front and back (on the same sheet of paper) of the original diploma previously sealed by the heads of the granting University and by the Ministry of Education (or similar agency) of the granting country. If the seal of the Ministry of Education is not available, that of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (or similar agency) of the granting country will suffice. In the case of Argentina, the required seal is that of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Culture of our country, unless the certification seal of La Haya is available. If the degree is in process, a declaration that attests it should be presented. All documents issued in a language other than Spanish should be submitted in its translated version made by an Argentine public translator, with his or her signature certified by Colegio de Traductores (Av. Corrientes 1834 C1022AAC Buenos Aires – Tel/Fax: 4373-7173);
- A photocopy of the final academic record of their Master's degree;
- Their GMAT exam results, preferably above 640;
- Their TOEFL exam results, preferably above 105;
- Their résumé;
- Three letters of recommendation in an envelope sealed and signed by the person who is referring;
- A monograph authored by themselves containing at least 3,500 words and proposing the research topic so that their thought clarity, level of education and ability to produce his or her own ideas based on scientific criteria can be evaluated.
- A letter of motivation that showcases their interests and how these relate to the System B objectives and their contribution to a new economy.

Entry Process

In the first phase, applicants will present the completed application, including all necessary documentation.

In the second phase, applicants will be interviewed by:

- the Academic Director of the doctorate;
- two members of the doctorate's Academic Committee;
- two members of System B;
- their potential Thesis Adviser.

During the interviews applicants will be observed as to their academic profile, commitment to research, and motivation.
